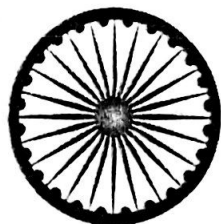

ACCELERATING INDIA FELLOWSHIP

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

A. About Policy, Politics and Governance Foundation:

The Policy, Politics and Governance Foundation (PPGF) was established to create exclusive opportunities for students and young professionals interested in the fields of policy, politics and governance. PPGF's initiatives have been crafted to strike uniquely at the heart of Indian policy, politics and governance. Our initiatives seek to provide effective and impactful engagements in the political sphere through a holistic understanding of both the art of political strategy and the science of policy and governance.

B. About Accelerating India Fellowship

Accelerating India Fellowship is a one-year immersive program designed to support exceptional individuals in producing book-length works that explore critical issues across culture, society, technology, economy, and politics. These works aim to contribute actionable ideas, historical insights, and visionary pathways to accelerate India's development and leadership in the 21st century. Along with generating such frontier ideas, another important goal of the Fellowship program is to nurture the next generation of bold young thinkers who can reimagine India's trajectory through fresh, dynamic, and impactful approaches.

C. We Define Our Ethos Thus

Progress: Emphasis on producing optimistic, forward-looking works that inspire action and solutions.

Rootedness: Deeply rooted in India's civilizational identity, ensuring relevance to India's unique challenges and opportunities while contributing to global discourse.

D. Thematic Focus Areas For The Fellowship:

- a. Culture and Identity
- b. Society and Institutions
- c. Politics and Policy
- d. Technology and Innovation
- e. Economy and Industry

Selection Process

The selection process is designed to identify individuals with exceptional potential to produce impactful, book-length works aligned with the ethos of the fellowship.

- a. Applicants must be 18 years or older and possess a Master's degree or higher; however, individuals with an undergraduate degree may be considered in exceptional cases.
- b. The selection criterion includes the alignment of submitted documents - the book proposal, the writing sample and the CV, followed by a round of interviews.
- c. Proposals are evaluated based on the originality and relevance of ideas, the clarity and feasibility of the book roadmap, the quality of writing, commitment to the project's completion, and alignment with the ethos of the Fellowship.

F. Grant Structure:

- a. A total of 15 Fellowship (can be increased on discretion) grants will be awarded. Fellows will receive a grant of ₹4/6/12 Lakhs, payable as a monthly stipend of ₹ 80,000 for the period of fellowship (4, 6, or 12 months), and the balance payable on the submission of the final manuscript.
- b. Additional travel grants will also be considered for the Fellows on a discretionary basis.
